Dear Parents,

Please can we remind you of the Parent Evaluation forms we sent home with your child/children recently. We need you to fill them in and let us have them back. Also we sent home forms regarding permission to take and use photographs of your child/children, please can we have these back also. Thank you.

For the second half of the Spring Term (22nd February—26th March 2010) we shall be looking at the topic of 'Things that Grow'. We shall be covering such items as babies growing into toddlers, school children and then adults. We shall make a height chart to see who is the tallest, make hand and foot prints to see who has the smallest and biggest.

Insects are another item and this will include spiders and The Hungry Caterpillar who eats lots of food and gets big and fat and later turns into a Butterfly.
