The topic for the second half of the Summer term (5th June—22nd July approx) is Land and Sea where we shall look at activities such as our favorite water and land animals and the noises they make. Hopefully we shall be able to listen to Whales making noises as they 'talk' to each other. Water play using various toys including a water wheel and pump, sea animals and boats.
