Dear Parents,

May we please remind you that we are open during the Half-Term Holiday the 25th—29th October 2010. (Please speak to Scott about spaces and deals!) During this week we shall be concentrating on Letters and Sounds and Jolly Phonics. This helps with speech and learning letter sounds ready for writing and later reading. Your child will be singing songs, making music, listening for different sounds and guessing what they are and telling us what sounds they can hear outside.

After the holiday our Topic will be Christmas Fun, where we shall be making decorations and Christmas tree. We shall also be decorating Gingerbread Men, talking about going Sledging and building Snowmen and making footprints in the snow. We will discuss the need to wear warm coats, hats, scarves and gloves along with our wellies when it snowing or raining. Included will be making Christmas cards and Calendars, collaging a Christmas cake and pudding. Hopefully we shall also be able to taste some mince pies along the way and decorate some biscuits.

We shall include the special days that occur during the second half of the winter term also such as making Fireworks like a rocket and painting a picture of a firework. We shall look at Diwali and color some lamps, collage a red poppy for Remembrance Sunday and make a flag of Scotland and paint a Thistle for St. Andrews day.
